
This Valentine's Day, we're giving primary (years 5 and 6) and secondary (years 7-11) school students the chance to get creative with a new photography competition!

We're asking schools and teachers to spread the word about our competition and, if possible, facilitate photography sessions to help as many children and young people take part as possible.







Get involved

To ensure the safety of participants, we're running the competition with the support of primary and secondary schools across the UK.


As an educator, you can support our competition by:

- Promoting the opportunity to staff and students.
- Helping students to take pictures for entry, encouraging creativity and positive values.
- Supporting students and parents to complete the required consent forms.
- Submitting entries on behalf of your school.











Get involved

We suggest nominating one member of staff to administrate entries. Each photo should be submitted via our <u>Online</u> <u>Entry Form</u>. Entries are only valid if the correct consent forms have been completed:

- Any entries that show children or young people under 18 require parental consent. Please use our <u>Parent/Carer and Child Consent</u> <u>Form.</u>
- If any adults are featured in the image, please ensure they have completed an <u>Adult Consent Form</u>.

Winners and runners-up will be invited to the Tender Awards 2025 in June, where they will be presented with a special award by one of Tender's celebrity Ambassadors. Shortlisted entrants will each receive £50 in theatre vouchers.

All entries, including winning, runnersup and shortlisted images, can also be used in school events, publicity and promotion to support school goals.









Rules and guidance



1.INSTRUCTIONS FOR SCHOOLS

- Assign a member of staff to manage entries on behalf of the school.
- Share competition details with eligible students, facilitating photography sessions where possible/appropriate.
- Instruct students to submit entries and consent forms to the dedicated member of staff (students should NOT submit entries online).
- Share and complete necessary consent forms (see below).
- Submit entries via Tender's Online Entry Form before 5pm, Friday 7th February.

2.JUDGING

Entries will be reviewed by a judging panel including Tender CEO Susie McDonald, members of our Youth Board and a celebrity Tender Ambassador. Two winners will be chosen from primary and secondary school respectively, alongside two runners up and a shortlist of three further entries from both categories.

Winners, runners-up and shortlisted entrants will be informed by 5pm, Thursday 13th February. The results will be publicly announced on Instagram and the Tender website on Friday 14th February.

3.PRIZES

Each winning student and runner-up will be invited to attend the Tender Awards 2025 with one friend and a school representative. Students will receive a special award from a celebrity guest during the ceremony. Shortlisted entrants will receive £50 theatre vouchers.

Winning and shortlisted images will be displayed across Tender's website, social media and at special Tender events. Prizes cannot be transferred or substituted.

4.CONSENT

For an entry to be eligible, please ensure you have gathered the required consent from anyone featured in the picture.

- If any children/young people under 18 are featured in the image, please ensure they and their parents have completed a <u>Parent/Carer and Child Consent Form</u>.
- If any adults are featured in the image, please ensure they have completed an <u>Adult</u> <u>Consent Form</u>.
- Entries without the required consent will be immediately withdrawn from the competition.
